Guidelines for PPT Presenters

- 1. <u>Slide Limit:</u> Ensure your presentation consists of no more than 10 slides, excluding the title and thank-you slides.
- **2.** <u>Time Allocation:</u> Allocate 7 to 8 minutes for your presentation, followed by 5 minutes for the Q&A session. Time adherence is mandatory.
- 3. <u>Submission Deadline:</u> Upload your presentation on the CMT portal by January 25, 2025. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- **4.** <u>Template Compliance:</u> Use the official template provided on the website. Any deviation must be pre-approved.
- **5.** <u>Content Quality:</u> Ensure the content is clear, concise, and visually engaging. Avoid excessive text and prioritize visuals to support your key points.

Guidelines for Poster Presenters

1. Poster Size and Layout:

- The poster should adhere to A1 size dimensions (594 x 841 mm).
- Use a vertical layout for optimal readability.
- **2.** <u>Theme Definition:</u> Clearly state the theme or focus of your poster to align with the conference's objectives.

3. Template and Logos:

- Follow the template provided on the website.
- If using your own design, ensure it prominently includes the ASCE IS NR logo.
- **4.** <u>Printing Responsibility:</u> Bring a printed copy of your poster to the venue. On-site printing facilities will not be available.
- 5. <u>Submission Deadline:</u> Submit a digital version of your poster by January 25, 2025, as specified on the website.
- **6.** <u>Design Tips:</u> Use legible fonts, professional color schemes, and a logical flow of information to enhance impact and readability.

- Ensure your materials comply with all provided templates and guidelines to avoid disqualification.
